The march on September 14th is a statement of solidarity with the people of Chile who have been struggling and organising against a brutal military dictatorship since the bloody coup on September 11th 1973.

The opposition to the regime has been growing and protesting more directly against the military junta since 1983. Many efforts have been made by the regime to counter this movement.

This culminated in the imposition of the State of Seige in November 1984, and gave the military license to unleash a massive wave of repression. It included measures which were similar to those taken in 1973 such as the rounding up of all men between the ages of 16 and 60 in the shanty towns, putting them into football stadiums and then proceeding to question, torture and release some of them.

Right wing death squads have also emerged who in March killed three leading members of the opposition. Although the State of Seige was lifted in June 1985 it has made very little difference to the tactics of the military of systematic terrorisation of the population.

The people of Chile however do not give up and continue to organise to survive and protest, it is vital that we reaffirm our support for them.

This march on the 14th September is calling for an end to repression and the denial of human rights in Chile today and

- the end of all British arms deals with Chile.
- the end of all trade aid and diplomatic links with the Chilean regime.
- the increase in moral and material support for the Resistance.
- the right of all exiles to return their homeland in safety.
